Welcome to our November Nannup Truffle Growers Cooperative Newsletter!

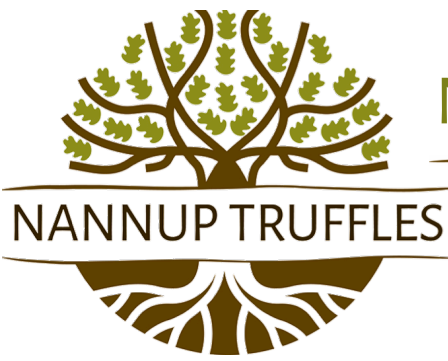
Since our last newsletter the farm has rapidly changed! Following on from the soil preparations and disking a few months ago, there has been a big change in the landscape as you can see.
